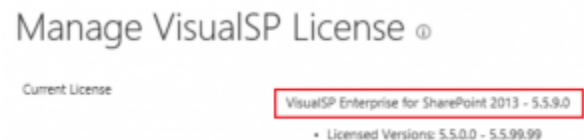
There are three ways to find your license information (Express, Standard, or Enterprise) and the version number, plus an additional way to find just the version number.

## From Central Administration

1. Go to Central Administration > General Application Settings:
2. Click on Manage VisualSP License:

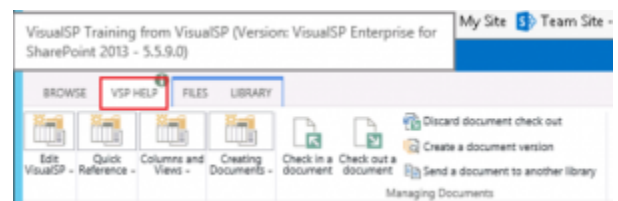


You will find the license type and version number on the following screen:



## Through the User Interface

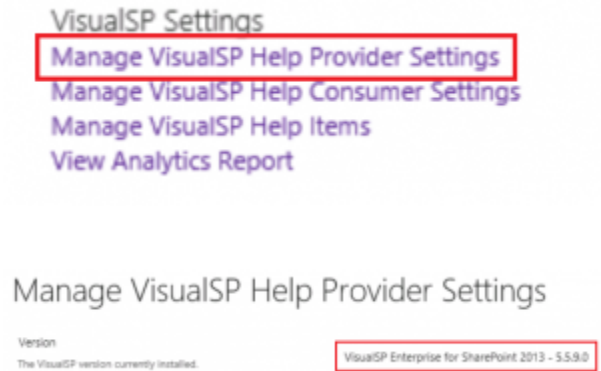
1. From the deployed help system, click on the Help tab. Once the Help tab is open, hover your mouse over the word "Help". You will see the license type and version number.



## From Site Settings

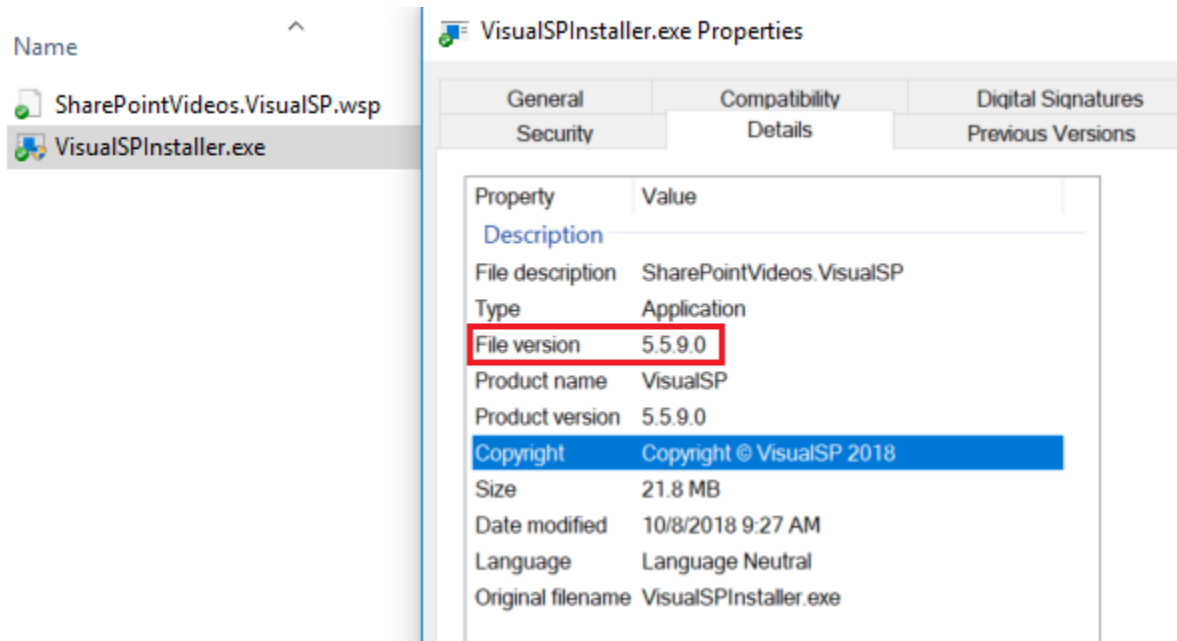
1. From Site Settings click on **Manage VisualSP Help Provider Settings**.

## From the executable file

If all you need is the version number, right click the VisualSP Help System executable (exe) file. Go to Properties → Details tab:
