

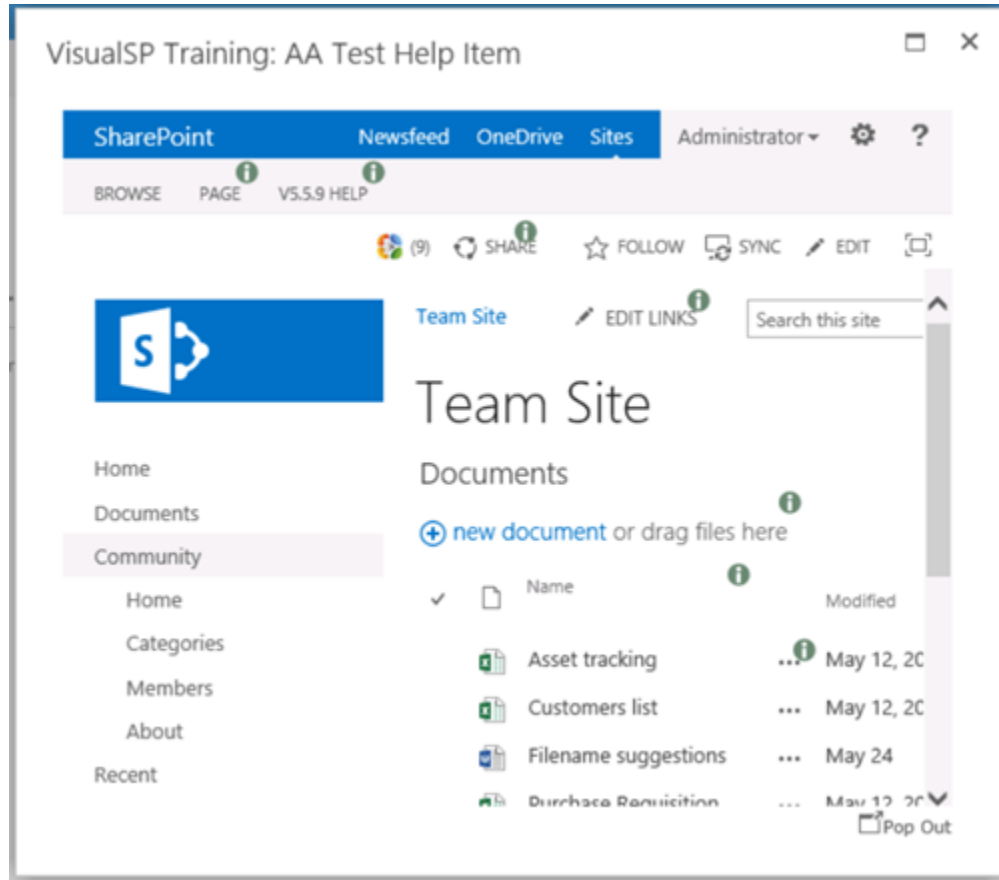
# Prevent SharePoint site navigation from displaying within a help item

If you configure an inline help item to display a SharePoint web page, the module window will also display the site navigation:



This is just the way SharePoint renders a SharePoint web page. To remove the site navigation from the module window, just add **?isdlg=1** to the end of the link URL. In the Help item editor window, the correct configuration will look like this:

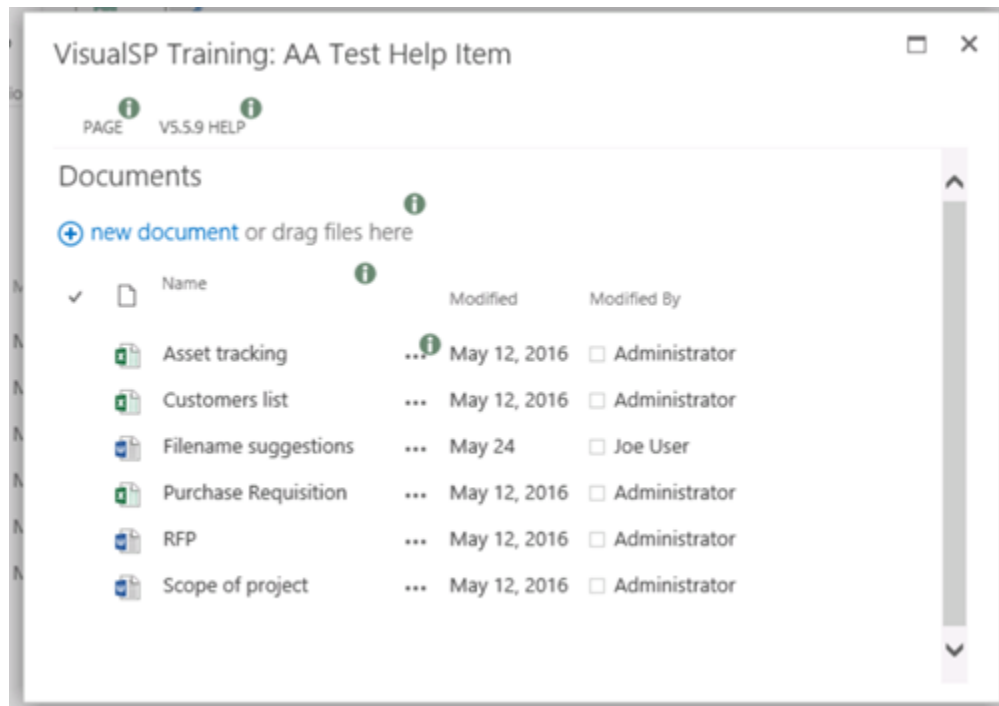
